Follow-up information:

A great training was held on July 26th for 33 district employees on the use of the Curriculum Connector program. Our trainer did a great job of both discussing the “whys” of mapping and the theory of its use, and the “hows” of using the computer program. The Literacy Leadership Team and some of the high school science teachers will be working on writing “core” maps this summer in the program.

We are reviewing the contract and implementation timeline for the SIS. We are hoping to have a target date to go live for September 2011.

Action Issues:

There is an issue regarding school physicians that will need to be heard by the board. See enclosed documentation. This is a delicate issue as we need to discuss the position issues in public, but if there are particular personnel issues, then we need to be in non-public.

Committee Work:
