As we begin our work in the new year, we will be refining our budget and our staffing negotiations as we prepare for the annual meeting in March.

Presentations:

The Educational Focus is a presentation by me about a new system in development for looking at an Adequate Education as an output model. This model factors in both growth and achievement and is very interesting. IT may eventually become a moot point as legislation changes adequacy, but the concepts are definitely worth exploring.

Follow-up information:

We will begin implementation of the bullying policy in January. I will have a meeting with District librarians and the town librarian on January 4th to discuss ways we can collaborate in program delivery. Mr. Pizzi, Mr. Whitehead, Dr. Winings, Kirk Spofford, and I met prior to vacation to discuss campus issues as part of the ongoing development of a District facilities master plan.
